BID Ratepayer Hearing on December 7

The Business Improvement District (BID) Ratepayer Advisory Board has adopted and is submitting their [2010 Management Plan and Budget](#) to the City of Spokane. The budget includes a \$100,000 general fund contribution from the City for the Clean and Safe program and an assessment roll of approximately \$973,485.

A public hearing is scheduled for Monday, December 7th at City Council to approve the budget, assessment roll and management plan for 2010. Ratepayers are welcome to attend and give their comments. For BID questions, please call 509.456.0580.
