Introduction / Mission

The Downtown Spokane Partnership (DSP) is seeking qualified proposals for the redevelopment of its website, **downtownspokane.org**.

Background

The DSP is dedicated to creating a dynamic, safe, vital, livable, and sustainable downtown as the foundation of a healthy regional economy. As part of this mission, we aim to enhance the functionality and user experience of **downtownspokane.org** to better serve members, ratepayers, partners, and the public.

SCOPE OF REQUIRED SERVICES

We are seeking a comprehensive redesign and redevelopment of downtownspokane.org. In addition to core functionality and content improvements, proposers must account for the following site capabilities and committee recommendations:

Core Functional Requirements

- Simple CMS management (e.g., WordPress, Drupal, or equivalent)
- Fully mobile-responsive design
- Updated visual design aligned with the DSP style guide
- Modern UX navigation based on best practices
- Member/ratepayer login functionality
- Database integration for business directory and events calendar (cross-referenced)
- Front-end submission for events
- Payment integration (QuickBooks plug-in preferred)
- Custom event map plugin for promotions (e.g., First Friday, Happy Hour) with front-end submission
- Social media integration
- Analytics and tracking integration
- Clear segmentation for business audiences and general public
- Turney promotion and project pages.

Content and Engagement Features

- Emphasize visual storytelling, with robust support for images and video
- A video update directory for easy access to regular multimedia updates
- Robust business directory with mapping and clear navigation for directory categories.
- Robust event calendar with directory integration, mapping, and clear event categories.
- Strong homepage storytelling and clear call-to-action for both public and members
- Highlight events, programs, and DSP initiatives through dynamic content blocks

- Dedicated Engagement Page: "How to get involved," volunteer opportunities, boards, and events
- Accessible newsroom feature to promote up to date topics.
- Clearly display hot topics and current projects
- Highlight "Who are our members" and "How to join"
- Continuous visual presence of **DSP logos and top sponsors** on all pages (e.g., footer)
- Promote the value of the DSP organization
- Click-and-go policy action tools for public and member use
- "Suggestion Box" feature for member/public input
- Current Member Events: public-facing calendar with a "featured for members" visual treatment
- Streamlined payment portal integrated with QuickBooks

 - o Public function (retail, entertainment, placemaking, brand engagement)
- Two to four graphic **design concepts**
- Recommendation for **CMS platform**
- Hosting, maintenance, and support plan
- Suggested third-party services or plug-ins
- Development timeline with milestones
- Team structure and role definitions
- Brief portfolio (≤3 pages) with examples of relevant work
- Three professional references (include name and contact info)
- Five (5) printed proposals, one unbound copy, and one digital version
