Re: Stay clean and safe

The downtown Clean Team encourages participants to dispose of materials safely. Please follow the tips below to ensure your clean up activity will be clean and safe for everyone.

- Please do not reach into bushes or other areas which may contain potentially harmful items such as drug paraphernalia, needles, broken glass, etc. If you do find any of these items please contact the Ambassadors or the clean team for pick-up.
- Stay away from biological waste.
- Follow all traffic signs and signals when crossing streets. If you are working on a sidewalk please wear a reflective safety vest.
- Please do not make any attempt at waking people up who may be in your way. Always contact your team leader if you need someone relocated.
- In case of an emergency please contact 911 and the Ambassadors or team lead.
- Use gloves at all times, do not pick anything up with your bare hands.
- Once a litter bag is full, tie it off and place out of the pedestrian path on a sidewalk corner and call a Clean Team member to pick it-up.

Special considerations to prevent the spread of COVID-19

- Must be 18 or older
- Not be a member of a high-risk age group or have underlying health conditions
- Volunteers will confirm they have not been in extended presence of any individuals known to have COVID or exhibit COVID symptoms within a two-week time period.
- Volunteers will model safe behaviors by agreeing to properly wear a mask for the duration of their shift and by wearing latex gloves provided by the DSP.
